In the same hours when the first medals in the history of padel at the **European Games** were being awarded in **Krakow**, in Novara many youngsters competed for the five **FIP PROMISES** titles.

Among the women, titles went to **Vittoria Girdi** and **Matilde Minelli** (Under 14, losing only four games in three matches) and to **Valentina Varazi** and **Aurora Buscaino** (Under 18).
