FIP RISE Iquique, Molina and Martinez try again to win in Chile

There are 22 pairs at the start of the **FIP RISE** in **Iquique**, a city in the north of Chile. **Cristobal Molina** and **Cristobal Martinez**, who are number 179 in the world ranking, lead the list of seeded players; on the other side of the 32-man draw with ten "bye" are **Carlos Luna** (Ecuador) and **Leonel Romano** (Argentina).

A tournament in which Molina and Martinez will try to win the title at home, something that did not happen in April in the FIP RISE in **Santiago** (where they were defeated in the final) and in July in the FIP RISE in **Concepcion**, when their run stopped in the quarter-finals.
