FIP PLATINUM Cdmx Club Libanés, Guerrero and Zapata triumph in Mexico City

The FIP PLATINUM final in Mexico City was exciting and balanced. It was won by Francisco Guerrero and Teodoro Zapata, number 8 on the draw, who won the second CUPRA FIP Tour event in their category (the first was played in Cagliari, Italy), beating 6-3 4-6 6-3 'Tolito' Aguirre and Cristian German Gutierrez.

"Thanks to everyone who supported us and the organisation of the tournament", were the words of the two Spaniards who, with this victory, gained 200 points in the FIP ranking. "I hope that padel in Mexico can grow more and more" – they added –. This was a beautiful tournament and to have won it is a great joy. They were very difficult matches, but we made it".
