FIP RISE Bourg en Bresse, the marathon of Mouriño and Huete

More than a padel tournament, it was a marathon. Argentina's **Federico Mouriño** and Spain's **Mario Huete Hernandez** won the **FIP RISE** in **Bourg en Bresse**, France, in front of a great crowd, in very tight matches. Forced to the third set already in the quarter-finals and semifinals, Mouriño and Huete – the number 3 seed on the draw – beat the Spaniards **Enrique Goenaga** and **Javier Martinez** (who led the entry list) in the deciding match with a score of 6-2 2-6 7-5. Fede and Mario hugged each other for a long time after the decisive point.

“A week that ends in the best possible way – Huete's words –. Thanks Fede for being by my side in this tournament, and thanks to the organisation for putting us in the best conditions to play. See you next year”. **Mouriño** and **Huete** are on the **Milano Premier Padel** entry list, admitted directly to the main draw: Mouriño will play with compatriot **Agustin Silingo**, Huete with **Diego Gil**, Spanish like him.
