FIP RISE Kaunas, Gutierrez and Windahl lead the draw

In this weekend, the **CUPRA FIP Tour** makes a stop in **Lithuania**, in **Kaunas**, the venue of a 30-pair **FIP RISE**, with the top two on the draw directly to the round of 16. Leading the entry list are two Top 60 players such as Argentina's **Cristian Gutierrez** (44) and Sweden's **Daniel Windahl** (54), who, after playing the Gothenburg tournament paired with Simon **Vasquez**, will try to impose with Gutierrez.

The number 2 seed are Spaniards **José Luis Gonzalez** and **Antonio Varo Ramos**. At the Kaunas Tennis Space there will be players from different countries, with Belgian **Maxime Deloyer** and Italian **Daniele 'Denny' Cattaneo** completing the seeded podium. Some Lithuanian pairs coming from the qualifiers: they will try to make a good impression at home.
