The Spaniard and the Argentine, the highest seed in the Puebla (3) draw, won the draw without losing a set and in the final they defeated (6-4 6-2) **Ricardo Martínez** and **Gerard Arnaldos Serrano**, after taking advantage of the withdrawal in the semifinals of **Christian Medina Murphy** and **Belar Vera Lopez**.
