FIP RISE Viña del Mar, many South Americans on court

While the world's best players for the last **Premier Padel** of the year, the **CUPRA FIP Tour** makes another stop in **South America**, with the first of two events to close the season. In **Viña del Mar**, Chile, a **FIP RISE** is scheduled, preceding another tournament in the same category scheduled next week in Caracas, **Venezuela**.

There are 32 pairs at the start, with Argentines **Pablo Nicolas Egea** (world number 184) and **Gonzalo Vera** (210) leading an entry list almost entirely made up of South American players. The only exception, among the pairs directly admitted to the main draw, the French **Philemon Raichman** and **Maxime Joris**.
