**FIP WORLD PADEL CHAMPIONSHIPS NORTH AMERICAN QUALIFIERS: MEXICO, UNITED STATES  
AND CANADA ON COURT IN MONTERREY ON 6 AND 7 SEPTEMBER**

**Monterrey** (Mexico) will host the **North American FIP World Padel Championships Qualifiers**, an event organized by **FEMEPA** (the Mexican Padel Federation) and the **International Padel Federation**, on September 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>. The men's and women's national teams of **Mexico, United States** and **Canada** will take to the court in a three-team group that will put two places (in the case of the men's competition) and one place (in the case of the women's competition) up for grabs for the final phase of the **FIP World Padel Championships** scheduled from 28 October to 2 November in Doha, Qatar.

Mexico and its federation confirm their great organizational skills and their passion for padel, as demonstrated by the two Premier Padel circuit tournaments on the 2024 calendar (the P1 in Acapulco last March and the Major scheduled for late November) and many tournaments in all categories of the CUPRA FIP Tour.

*"The North American FIP World Padel Championships Qualifiers represent another important step towards the biggest event in terms of team competitions: the FIP World Padel Championships 2024 in Doha – said FIP president **Luigi Carraro** –. The continental challenges for World Championships qualification are providing show and passion, confirming how the major team events organized by the FIP with the cooperation of the host countries and their federations are increasingly central to the world of padel and the enthusiasm of the fans. I would like to thank **Jorge Mañe**, president of FEMEPA, and all those who have collaborated and will collaborate in the success of this great event".*

*"In the city of Monterrey Nuevo Leon, teams from the United States, Mexico, and Canada will try to conquer their place in the FIP World Padel Championships, the most important padel competition in the world, which will be held in Doha, Qatar, next November – said **Jorge Mañe**, president of FEMEPA –. The facilities at Club Sfera in the city of Monterrey are ready and while we await the arrival of the protagonists, we appreciate the support that FIP has given to FEMEPA to be able to host this important event for North American players, where we hope to be up to the task of ensuring the success of the competition".*

The schedule will be the same for men and women: **Mexico-Canada** and **USA-Canada** will open the competition on Friday September 6<sup>th</sup>. On Saturday, September 7<sup>th</sup>, **Mexico** and **United States** will play the last tie.
