GROUP SIZE

Men's qualifiers

4 groups (3 groups with 4 teams & 1 group with 3 teams).

Men's teams:

Australia, Bahrain, China, Egypt, Iran, Japan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Oman, Philippines, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Thailand, Tunisia & United Arab Emirates.

Women's teams

Australia, Bahrain, China, Egypt, Iran, Japan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Oman, Philippines, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Thailand, Tunisia & United Arab Emirates.

Women's qualifiers

4 groups (3 groups with 4 teams & 1 group with 3 teams)

Deadline to submit the national roster: **23 August**

Deadline to cahnge players due to justified injured: **18 Septiembre**

Line-up submission and order of play:

One (1) hour before the first match of the tie, the coach must submit the team's line-up with the three pairs. At this time, a copy of the opposing team's line-up, including the order of play as listed on their form, will be exchanged with the other coach.

The order of play will be:

- Pair Number 3
- Pair Number 2
- Pair Number 1

Once submitted, line-up changes are only permitted in the following instances:

- Confirmed injury by the tournament medical team prior to the first tie match.
- Incorrect line-up submitted initially.

Any casualty during the elimination will be considered as a lost Match by 6.0 / 6.0.

Pre-Match Procedures:

Prior to each match, the referee will verify player identification. Players may present a copy, photograph, or the original passport or ID.

Completion of All Matches:

All group stage matches must be played in their entirety.

RESOLUTION OF TRIPLE TIE (Regulation III.1.5)

In the event of a tie involving three pairs or three teams in point-based competitions, the specific Technical Regulations governing that competition shall take precedence. If no provision is made therein, the following procedure will be applied.

For team competitions with a three-way tie.

For team competitions with a three-way tie:

- 1.- The difference in matches won and lost among the three tied teams will be determined. If the tie persists, proceed to step 2.
- 2.- The difference in sets won and lost among the three tied teams will be determined. If the tie persists, proceed to step 3;
- 3.- The difference in games won and lost among the three tied teams will be determined. If the tie persists, proceed to step 4;
- 4.- A draw of lots will be conducted.

Once the triple tie is resolved and a two-way tie remains, the winner of the direct match between the two teams will be declared the winner.

PLAYERS PLAYING OUTFIT

Players on the same team must wear identical uniforms and avoid displaying logos from other tournaments, continental associations, or international federations.

In the event that both teams competing in a match share identical colors, the higher-ranked team will have the privilege of wearing their primary uniform. The lower-ranked team will be obligated to select an alternate uniform color.

(Please note that each team is required to have two distinct national kit colors).
