





SUPPORT HEALTHY LIFESTYLES

We promote the adoption of healthy lifestyles through padel, encouraging people of all generations, in particular the youth, to embrace physical activity as a key component of their well-being.

Partnerships: We collaborate with local governments, civil society organisations and affiliated federations to expand access to padel for disadvantaged communities.

We design padel-based programmes to address specific *social issues*, such as health promotion, social inclusion and gender equality.

We encourage our National Federations to adopt an inclusive approach and implement initiatives to engage with their local communities.
