INTRODUCTION



The International Padel Federation (FIP) brings together national and continental padel federations.

As the organizer of international competitions, FIP is the central hub of an ecosystem that includes host cities, national federations, local promoters, sports ministries and Olympic committees, as well as equipment suppliers and sponsors. Through its training and educational initiatives, FIP also has an impact on players, coaches, referees and other padel stakeholders globally.



Padel is a Growing sport and is assuming an increasingly relevant role in the sports landscape. Therefore, it is essential that FIP, given its influence in the padel community, actively commits **to promoting sustainability** and assumes its ethical and environmental responsibilities.

FIP understands sustainability as a development that encompasses the environmental, economic and social dimensions. In other words, it is about meeting present needs without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs. Thus, FIP assumes its social, cultural, environmental and economic responsibility to ensure a positive legacy for future generations.

WHAT WE DO

Ball recycling: innovative uses for tournament balls beyond their initial purpose. For example, consider using them as sound-absorbing materials by incorporating them into the legs of chairs and tables in school and hospitals.

Net recycling: Promote the use of recycled materials in court constructions, such as repurposing discarded fishing nets.

Plastic reduction: Minimize the use of single-use plastics at events. Partnerships with beverage companies that utilize recycled materials in their packaging and offer eco-friendly options.

Signage: All panels and visual communication media of the events printed on recycled materials, mainly cardboard, thus minimizing their environmental impact.

Waste management: Partner with local organizations to implement proper waste management and recycling programs at padel events.

Energy efficiency: Encourage clubs and tournament venues to use energy-efficient lighting and appliances. Renewable energy: Explore opportunities to use solar or other renewable energy sources at padel facilities.

Sustainable transportation: Prioritize eco-friendly transportation, such as electric or hybrid vehicles. Coordinate arrivals to consolidate transport needs and reduce the number of shuttle trip.

Inclusion: Implement gender-neutral prize money in tournaments.

Develop educational programs on sustainability: Design online courses that teach coaches, players and referees the importance of sustainable actions.

Use social media for public outreach: leverage social media to communicate the progress of sustainable initiatives, build awareness, and inspire the padel community.

Coaching development: Develop accessible online and in-person coaching education programs focused on inclusive coaching practices and sportsmanship.

Educational resources: Create free online resources (videos, articles) about padel techniques.

Volunteer roles: Tailor training and role assignments to individual skills and interests such a ballboys, court side assistance, event logistics, hospitality.

Ethical and sustainable practices for suppliers: Ensuring fair labor conditions, minimizing environmental impact throughout their operations.

Promote active participation: Encourage tournaments and clubs to offer introductory padel sessions for all ages and abilities, emphasizing the health benefits of a regular physical activity.

Healthy venues: Ensure tournaments and club facilities have healthy food options, water fountains, and are smoke-free environments.

Sport with disabilities: Ensure that padel is accessible and inclusive for all individuals with disabilities, such as those in wheelchairs or with intellectual disabilities.




FIP integrates these activities into a standard checklist for all its events, making sustainability a measured and reported aspect of each competition.

This systematic approach enables FIP to adjust and strengthen its sustainability efforts from one event to the next.


ENVIRONMENTALLY:
